With our remote scan service, you don't need to travel to one of our pop-ups. Instead, with just a few simple photos (and an optional short video), I can create a detailed 3D model of your bump, ready to be turned into a sculpture.

How to capture your scan

✦ Step 1: Choose Your Moment

We recommend that you capture the pictures between weeks 30–36, but the decision is yours.

✦ Step 2: Capture Your Angles

- Take clear photos in the same pose (front, left, right, back).
- However the more photographs the better!
- Send the original files (no filters, no edits).
- Use soft daylight — avoid shadows or flash.

✦ Step 3: Optional Video

Film a 10–15 second clip slowly turning in the same pose. This helps capture subtle details.

✦ Step 4: Share With Me

Send your files directly to contact@bumpandsculpture.co.uk

✦ Step 5: Time to edit

Your files are sent to a 3D specialist to create a digital model of your sculpture. You will get a preview to check you're happy, at this stage you will have unlimited revisions before we get crafting your sculpture.

✦ Step 6: Crafting

We will then take 16-24 weeks to craft your sculpture, we will keep you updated on the process

GUIDANCE

Assistance

We recommend asking a partner or friend to help take your photographs. This not only ensures better angles and framing but also helps maintain the correct distance and focus.

Camera Position

Stand approximately 1.5–2 meters away from the subject.

Step back and zoom in slightly (1.5x–2x) to reduce wide-angle distortion, which can affect proportions.

Hold the camera level with the subject's midsection for consistent perspective.

Angles

Please capture the following views, maintaining the same relaxed, natural pose throughout: Front, Left Side, Right Side, Back. A photograph from birds eye view of the bump and one from the floor view. For baby scans please include a close up of their face, hands and feet.

Lighting

Natural, indirect daylight is best - photograph near a window or in a well-lit space. Avoid using flash as it can cause harsh shadows and unnatural tones.

Clothing

For the most accurate finish, no underwear or close-fitting garments are ideal.

If you prefer to stay more covered, that's completely fine - we can smooth clothing lines digitally.

Background

A plain, uncluttered wall is ideal for clarity, but not essential.

Next Steps

Confirm your booking

Contact us with your full name, email, telephone number and postal address. Let us know when you will be providing your pictures, what size sculpture you would like. We will send an invoice of £100 for the deposit. The remaining balance can be paid once you have confirmed you're happy with the digital files. Once full payment has been made we will start to craft your sculpture.

Send us the photographs

Once you have captured your photographs, email them over to contact@bumpandsculpture.co.uk. Please add notes, for example if you would like any smoothing. Confirm your final decision on size and colour. 3D specialist will then turn these into 3D files. Once complete you will be shown the result, to ensure you're happy before we start to craft your sculpture.

Magic is happening

It will then take us between 16-24 to finish your keepsake. We will keep you updated on the process and will reach out before sending it out for delivery.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When is the best time in pregnancy to book my scan?

A: Most parents choose between weeks 30–36 when the bump is beautifully rounded. But every journey is unique, so choose the week that feels right for you.

Q: Do I need special equipment for the scan?

A: No, just your phone! As long as you follow the simple guide (photos from 6 angles, optional short video), the more photos the better, we will take it from there!

Q: How long does it take?

A: Once your photos are sent, the 3D specialist creates your model within 12 days. You'll receive a preview and we'll make unlimited revisions until you're happy. Sculptures are then handcrafted and finished, ready in 16-24 weeks.

Q: What finishes can I choose from?

A: A wide range - from soft whites, nudes and bright colours. You can also choose from antique bronze and copper. Each finish gives a unique look to your piece.

Q: Can you ship internationally?

A: Yes! Sculptures can be shipped worldwide. Shipping costs vary by country and will be confirmed at booking.

Q: What if I change my mind after seeing the preview?

A: You'll get unlimited revisions on your 3D model to make sure you're 100% happy before your sculpture is created.
